The IEP Quality (IEPQ) Tutorial is a resource developed at the University of Illinois with funding from the federal Institute of Education Sciences and ISBE. It is a web-based site designed to assist Illinois Individualized Education Program teams in writing quality IEPs that are individualized, based on data, connected to standards, and clearly tied to a student's instructional needs. IEPQ provides best-practice guidance, examples, downloadable resources, and interactive Goal Assistant Tools that guide users through the process of writing IEP goals aligned to state standards.

It will cover registration, the Toolbox, Resource Library, Student Scenarios, Help Topics, and a brief overview of the Goal Assistant programs.
